Warsaw – No parking fees for the healthcare staff

Hospital and ambulance employees who have direct contact with patients can park in the toll zone free of charge. Thanks to this measure they will be able to access their workplace more easily.

The city counts 8,600 commercial premises, which are rented by entrepreneurs. These include shops, restaurants, services providers, day nurseries, and nursery schools.

The city has introduced various support measures for the tenants regarding rent payment and debts.
