



Below are the scope and the content of our municipality's struggle against Covid-19, from March 17th to April 20th:

DISINFECTION WORKS

1. All the official buildings (including but not limited to district governorship, police station, social security institution, hospitals, primary health care centers, schools, banks, tax office) were disinfected by the teams of our Cleaning Services Management
2. Places that are heavily used by the people, such as public parks, mosques, **cemevis**, bus stops, marketplaces, playgrounds, ATMs were disinfected
3. Pharmacies, accepted to be of high pandemic risk because of intense circulation, were disinfected
4. Dumpsters and their surroundings in all of our neighborhoods across our city were washed and disinfected. This is a daily activity that is still carried out.
5. Garbage trucks, cleaning machines, buses and shuttles serving to the municipality are disinfected regularly.
6. All the buildings of our municipality (including the management offices, worksites, gyms, and restaurants) are disinfected.
7. Those areas and spots which risk contact due to extensive use by our administrative staff and citizens, such as elevators, stair railings, toilets, door handles, are regularly disinfected.
8. Disinfectants were installed at certain points of our buildings, serving to the public and our staff.
9. All the air conditioners in our buildings are disinfected.
10. Buildings of all the political parties in our city were disinfected.
11. Disinfection works are carried out with drones.

AWARENESS RAISING ACTIVITIES

12. Trained personnel are measuring the temperature of those staff and citizens entering and exiting our main building. Directions are given if necessary, after providing information.
13. Our personnel assigned to disinfection and cleaning positions were trained on how to protect themselves from the coronavirus.
14. Banners with motivational aspirations for healthcare workers were hung on the crossroads and main routes, especially around the private and public hospitals within our borders.
15. Information regarding the measures to be taken to fight against coronavirus are regularly shared from the official social media accounts of our Municipality and our Mayor.
16. Banners reading as “Stay At Home” and “Wash Your Hands” were hung on all the billboards that our municipality is entitled to use within the boundaries of our district.
17. Banners and 100,000 posters containing information on how to the fight coronavirus were hung in all our neighborhoods.
18. Our theater group staged plays, without audience, to inform the children about the hygiene rules to be followed. Those recordings were shared both on our social media accounts and sent to our citizens via SMSs.
19. Family Counseling service for adults is provided via phone. In addition, videos concerning this subject were recorded and shared on our social media accounts.
20. Exercise-at-home videos for those who opt for a healthy life at home were shared on our social media accounts.
21. Psycho-social support services are also provided through the Family Counseling Line.
22. The Information Booklet containing all kinds of information about the coronavirus (Covid-19) outbreak was prepared and uploaded to the official website of our municipality.
23. Gift sets of coloring books were prepared by our Environment Directorate to increase environmental awareness for the children of healthcare workers.

MEASURES TAKEN IN RELATION TO THE PERSONNEL

24. In order to protect the health of our municipal personnel, posters covering information on 25-points, such as general rules and internal measures to be observed in the workplaces, were hung in all our buildings.
25. Our personnel with disabilities and chronic conditions in the risk group and our female staff with children under the age of 12 were sent on paid leave.
26. In the buildings and facilities of our municipality, staff and visitor entrances and exits are provided through a single door.
27. Disinfection Unit was established at the entrance of our building to protect the health of our personnel.

28. In order to protect the health of our municipal personnel, we replaced regular taps in all our buildings with sensor taps.
29. Newspapers/magazines are not allowed into our buildings in order to reduce the risk of contacting and spreading viruses.
30. Personal trash cans, under tables of each personnel, were replaced with a single bucket.
31. Aprons, masks and gloves were provided for the personnel. Staff was informed about how to use them.
32. The use of gloves has been made compulsory for our employees who come into contact with money.
33. Non-contact hand drying devices in the toilets of the building were replaced.
34. glass and ceramic glasses used in the teahouses within the buildings were replaced with disposable paper cups. Sugar is supplied in single packages.
35. Use of hand disinfectants made obligatory for the personnel who has to give their fingerprints entering and exiting the workplace.
36. Ozone generators are started to be used within the building. With the ozone generator, the air in the closed environments, where our personnel work, is cleaned.
37. In order to protect the health of our municipal workers, working with a significant effort in the fight against coronavirus, UVC Lamp systems, disrupting and neutralizing the DNA of viruses, were installed in our Municipality buildings.
38. Municipal Assembly meeting was held over a Zoom connection. The measures taken against the coronavirus were explained, and the opinions of the participants were received.

HEALTH EQUIPMENT PRODUCTION AND PREVENTIVE MEASURES

39. We held a meeting with chief physicians / officials of public and private hospitals within the boundaries of Çiğli district. We have created a "Health Committee". We are working with coordination in the district.
40. In order to meet the mask needs of healthcare professionals working in hospitals in our district, we sew masks in cooperation with Çiğli Public Education Center.
41. Face shields are produced for health workers. The shields are produced by 3D printers from PVC water pipes and are distributed to the hospitals.
42. Intubation Boxes are produced for health workers and distributed to hospitals.
43. "Contactless Sample Cabinets" which will provide a controlled sample from citizens going to hospitals, were produced and distributed to hospitals.
44. As an important step in the production of respiratory equipment, we started domestic blower production in Çiğli.
45. Face shields was delivered to all pharmacies in our district.
46. District Police Department was visited due to the Police Week and face shields were delivered to the police officers.

47. The guesthouse used by Çiğli Municipality Football Team was prepared and opened to the use of health workers working in the district to meet their accommodation needs.
48. Orange and kiwis, as source of vitamin C, were distributed to health workers working in hospitals located in our district.

MEASURES AT MARKET PLACES

49. As part of the fight against coronavirus, we wash and disinfect the market places, which are among the high risk areas, with foamy water. We distribute gloves and masks to our citizens and market tradesmen. In addition, information posters were hung in all our marketplaces.
50. We regularly control prices at the markets with the help of our Municipal Police Department teams.

SERVICES TO OUR CITIZENS

51. We have collected the names and contact details of our citizens who are 65 years or older or who need help. We help them with their grocery or pharmacy shopping, and other issues.
52. We also provide soup and bread on a daily basis to our chronic patients aged 65 and over as they cannot leave the house.
53. Our personal care team, which provides services for patients, the elderly and the disabled, distributed medical hair and personal cleaning materials to the elderly and disabled citizens.
54. The bread we produced was distributed to the citizens who could not leave their homes due to the curfew on April 11th and 12th.
55. Stickers reading as "Stay At Home" were affixed to the streets.
56. Food boxes were given to those who demanded among the relatives of martyrs and veterans, and their other needs were met.
57. Daily communication is established with our citizens who receive home care services by our Health Affairs Directorate, their status is checked and information about this process is provided.

REGULATIONS FOR OUR MUNICIPAL SERVICES

58. Taking into consideration the risks that crowded environments may cause on the health of our citizens and employees, a limited number of citizens are served at the same time in the municipal building. Our citizens are taken in a certain order to our units so that the distance can be maintained.
59. In order to protect against the virus, all correspondence within the institution is continuously transmitted to the authorities / employees electronically.

60. It was decided that there will be no meetings organized in the units of our municipality, if necessary, all meetings will be held among the groups virtually.
61. Employees who have traveled abroad, or who has a close family member who have travelled, were prevented from entering their workplaces for 14 days.
62. Ambulances, funeral coaches and vehicles for the disabled were frequently disinfected.
63. Elevators are cleaned frequently, and a warning note is up mentioning they need to be used if mandatory and by maximum two people.
64. Line infrastructure works were initiated to establish communication on a separate line to work in the event of a possible crisis.
65. A disinfectant cabin was installed at the entrance to the service building. Both staff and citizens are disinfected at the entrance and exit.
66. Shoe covers were placed at the entrance of the service building. The use of overshoes within the institution was made compulsory.
67. The heavily used benches were removed.
68. ENVIRONMENTAL WASTE LINE Works 24 hours a day, personnel reinforcements were made.
69. Through our Environmental Protection and Control Directorate, we take non-domestic wastes from the homes of our citizens, thus support them to stay at home.

MEASURES FOR STREET ANIMALS

70. Food is distributed on a daily basis for street animals

CANCELED EVENTS

71. All activities to be organized by our municipality were canceled.
72. Education Center and nurseries of our municipality were closed.
73. All facilities operated by our Municipality were closed until a second order in order to prevent people from gathering, and to maintain social distance.
74. Through our teams of the Municipal Police Department, we supervise the decision of the "closure of public places of entertainment and services" taken by the relevant ministries within the scope of the fight against the Coronavirus.

MEASURES AGAINST THE EXTENSION OF THE PREVENTION

75. In case of a possible crisis, we started storing basic food and hygiene materials to be delivered to those in need of care.
76. 78. In case of a possible crisis, places to be allocated to hospitals were determined.
