

Tallinn's COVID-19 restrictions exit plan

Mitigation measure	Conditions
Direct support measures	
Exemption from paying the parent's share of the expenses of the municipal kindergartens	Will continue until May 31
Support for parents whose children attend private kindergartens for paying study fees	
Support for a child's parent, child's guardian or guardian of a child in substitute homes to pay for the costs of childcare services in day care facilities	
Public transport is temporarily free for all public transport users in Tallinn	
Services of hobby schools	Hobby schools, where contact lessons restart on May 18, will give out invoices for the services provided. No invoices will be issued in those hobby schools where distance learning will continue after 18 May. Contact lessons can only be conducted one-on-one or in groups of up to five people.
Distributing school food packages	Will continue until June 3 2020
I phase: starting from May 11 2020	
Public playgrounds, sports grounds and dog walking areas	Will be opened gradually from 11 May 2020 on the course of the week subject to the order of cleaning. Playgrounds and outdoor gyms are washed before opening. First, playgrounds that had been restricted by municipal police tapes will be opened, and gradually playgrounds closed by using temporary fences will also be opened for use. Outdoor skate parks will be opened, indoor skate parks remain closed. Only the facilities that have been opened may be used.
Kindergartens	If necessary, additional kindergarten groups with a reduced number of children (6-8 children per group). Proper disinfection of the rooms and the provision of personal protective equipment for the employees must be ensured. Employees are obliged to use personal protective equipment when communicating with parents and other people who are not part of the kindergarten staff (the condition does not apply to communication with children in the kindergarten).
Play and sports grounds of general education school's (e.g school stadiums)	It is allowed to open the grounds by the decision of the administration of the institution (eg school) provided that the school is ready to ensure compliance with the 2

	+ 2 requirement and disinfection.
Opening outdoor stadiums, sports grounds, rowing centre and sport fields of the city for outdoor training sessions	Outdoor training is allowed. Ensure the availability of disinfectants, regular cleaning of surfaces, appropriate personal protective equipment for employees.
Further opening of the Tallinn Botanic Garden grounds	The contact-free use of the outdoor area of the botanical garden will be opened to guests with a ticket. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Further provision of Tallinn Mental Health Centre services	The provision of special care rehabilitation services will be restarted on site.
Partial reinstating of the library services	Contact-free returning of the borrowed books and other items will begin. Proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured.
Road and street maintenance	Thorough cleaning of the streets by May 15 2020
Public objects	Opening of the fountains in the public parks by May 15 2020
II phase: starting May 18 2020	
Branch libraries	Branches of the libraries (11 service points) will be reopened. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Museums	Opened for the public starting May 19th. The museums will ensure compliance with the orders of the Government of the Republic and the code of conduct of the Ministry of Culture. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
General education schools and hobby schools	Distance learning will be implemented until the end of the academic year. Starting from May 18 2020, one-on-one lessons or those in groups of up to five people are allowed. If the compliance with the 2+2 requirement is ensured, there is no obligation to wear personal protective equipment. In the case of consultations with more than one student, the teacher must use personal protective equipment. The compliance with the additional orders of the Government of the Republic in organizing the study processes must be ensured.
Youth centres	In the case of outdoor activities, the requirements of general education and hobby schools are to be followed. Only one-on-one activities are allowed indoors. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal

	protective equipment must be ensured for employees. Groups of up to 10 people are allowed. The compliance with the additional orders of the Government of the Republic in organizing the study processes must be ensured.
Tallinn City Archives	The research hall will be opened according to the summer schedule. Up to 5 people are allowed in the hall at a time. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Tallinn Vital Statistics Department	The provision of vital statistics services that require the personal presence of the recipient of the service will be continued. Family members are allowed to be present for the wedding ceremonies. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Tallinn Botanic Garden	The indoor spaces will be opened for the public. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Tallinn Zoo	The outdoor areas will be opened for the public. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Käo Support Centre	Opened partially for provision of some activities in smaller groups. According to the number of clients, up to 4 clients + 2 employees can be present in one group. Provision of proper disinfection measures and the personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Support Centre Juks	Opened partially for provision of some activities in smaller groups. According to the number of clients, up to 4 clients + activity instructor or 4 clients + 2 activity instructors can be present in one group. Provision of proper disinfection measures and the personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Iru Nursing Home	Welcoming new customers will begin. When accepting new customers, isolation measures will be applied, new customers are placed in separate rooms if possible. In addition, an internal movement restriction from one department to another is imposed on the clients and employees. Provision of proper disinfection measures and the personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Tallinn Family Centre	On-site psychological counselling will restart for whom it is more effective than distance counselling. The centre will also organize meetings between the child and the separated parent as a contact service in critical

	cases and on the same principle, offer family reconciliation service. Provision of proper disinfection measures and the personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Tallinna Social Work Centre	Re-socializing services are offered for the new clients provided that there are vacancies and upon the decision of the decision made by the commission. Provision of proper disinfection measures and the personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Suur-Sõjamäe 6a Day Centre	The provision of services will begin. Provision of proper disinfection measures and the personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Tallinn Cemeteries	The chapel of Pärnamäe cemetery (in cooperation with Tallinn Crematorium), the chapel of Liiva cemetery, the chapel of Siselinna cemetery, the chapel of Rahumäe cemetery and the chapel of Metsakalmistu will be opened. Rahumäe Cemetery and Liiva Cemetery will be opened for post-funeral get-togethers (<i>peied</i>). Provision of proper disinfection measures and the personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Public objects	Public toilets will be opened starting from May 18 2020
III phase: starting from June 1st 2020	
Tallinn Zoo	Indoor spaces will be opened, including cafes and shops. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Day centres and social centres for the elderly	A more detailed list of services provided will be determined during May. Compliance with the 2+2 requirement, proper disinfection measures and the provision of personal protective equipment must be ensured for employees.
Public beaches	Compliance with the 2+2 requirement must be ensured.
Opening Aegna island ship route	The compliance with the orders of the Government of the Republic and the guidelines of the Health Board must be ensured.
Provision of services of which's reinstating needs a relevant decision of the Government of the Republic	
Opening sport halls, saunas, pools, culture centres, Tallinn City Theatre, Tallinn Philharmonic Society	The City Government shall determine the conditions after the establishment of the respective requirements by the Government of the Republic.
